

Funding and Incentives for Homeowners Installing Solar PV Systems

Canada's plan to reach Net 0 by 2050 has resulted in more incentives for homeowners installing solar PV systems. Between microgeneration, grants, interest-free financing, and utility savings, 2023 is the optimal time to invest in renewable energy. Incentives and rebates we recommend...

For Home-Owners...

The **Canadian Greener Homes** Initiative offer grants and loans for home evaluations and retrofits. New solar PV systems, solar PV system expansions and off-grid solar PV systems are eligible for the Solar PV grant. Systems can be roof or ground mounted but must be within the property lines for the application address.

Potential funding...

Up to \$5000 for installation of a Solar Photovoltaic System.

Up to \$600 towards the total cost of EnerGuide evaluations.

Up to \$40,000 interest free loan with a repayment term of 10yrs.

Eligibility

- You must own the property and live there as a primary resident.
- An EnerGuide evaluation must be performed before your application. *Solar PV Systems installed without an EnerGuide Evaluation completed first are not eligible.*
- The system must consist of one or more PV panels and inverters which are certified to CSA standards and have a peak power capacity of 1kW DC or greater.
- Installation must be completed by a licensed professional such as Solun Ltd.
- A copy of written approval for interconnection from a local electrical or building authority is required. Solun will apply on your behalf.

Application Process

- Free solar assessment from Solun.
- Complete Pre retrofit EnerGuide Evaluation.
- Apply for grant/loan from Federal government.
- Obtain approval for funding.
- Install solar system with Solun.
- Post – retrofit EnerGuide Evaluation.
- Submit receipts and post-retrofit documents to government.
- Receive reimbursement from government.
